RAPID MEDICAL EVALUATION

The PA, NP or Physician evaluates your primary concerns while you are in Triage in order to expedite your work-up. Your labs and radiology studies are started during this process while you are in the waiting room.

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TESTING

Tests are ordered based on your concerns. While some tests can be sent immediately, you and your providers will discuss if more are needed. Common wait times for tests (*subject to condition being treated and patient volume*):

- Lab tests (1 hour)
- X-ray (1 hour)
- CT Scan (2 hours)
- CT with IV Contrast (3 hours)
- CT with oral contrast (4 hours)
- Ultrasound (3 hours)

TREATMENT

When we can do so safely, we strive to start appropriate treatment(s) as soon as possible. ***Please remind us if you take medications and/or have any allergies.***

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DISCHARGE AND FOLLOW-UP

You and your healthcare provider will review the following:

- Your primary concerns
- Your physical exam findings, tests and results
- Your treatments and response (when applicable)
- Your follow-up care:
 - Discharge to home, admission to hospital or transfer to another care center
